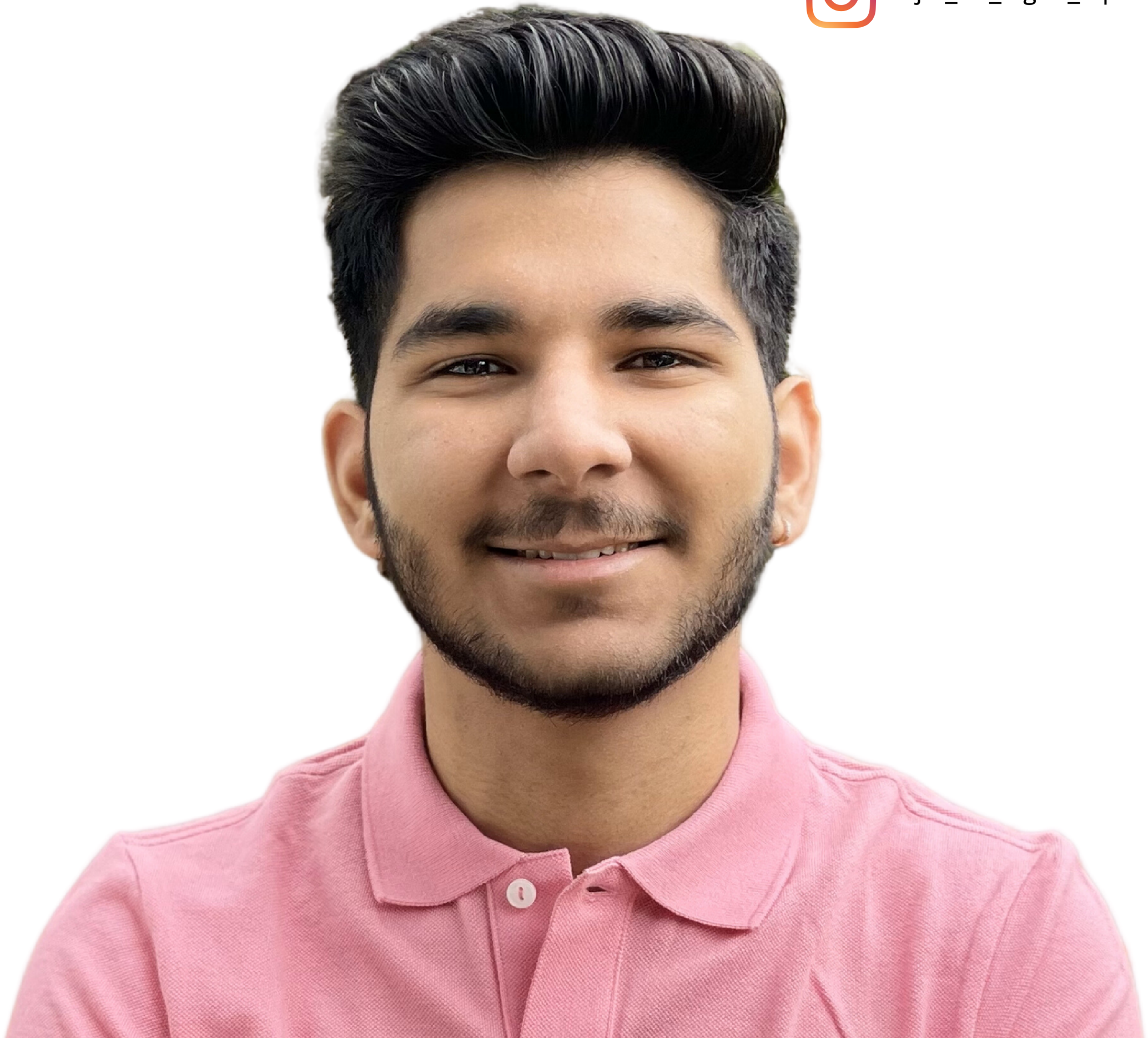

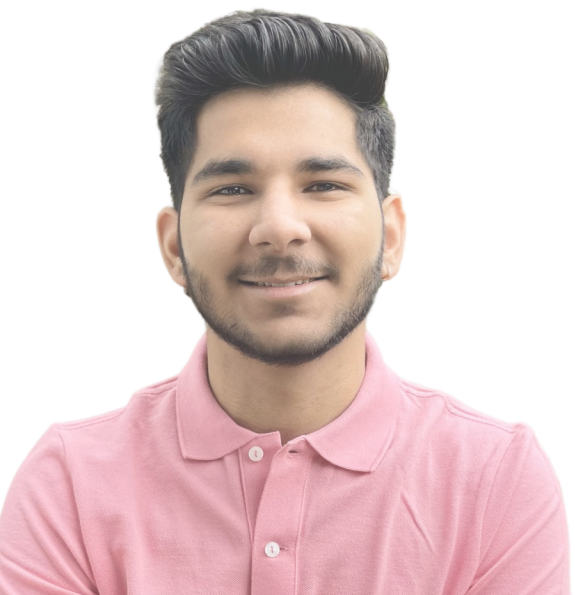

1. Student Networking Events

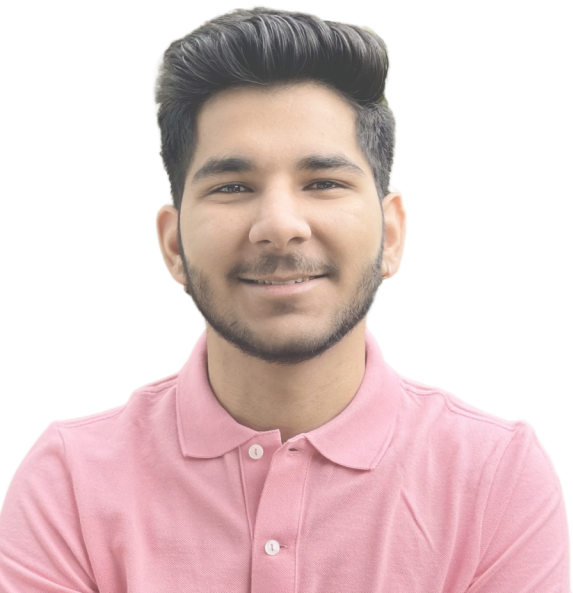
Organize regular workshops and networking opportunities to connect students with industry professionals for career development by collaborating with MSA.
